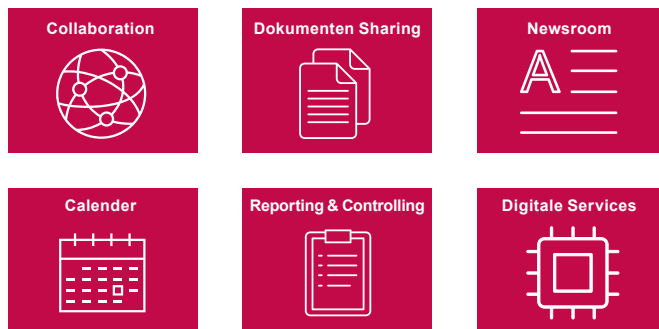
Our offer:
